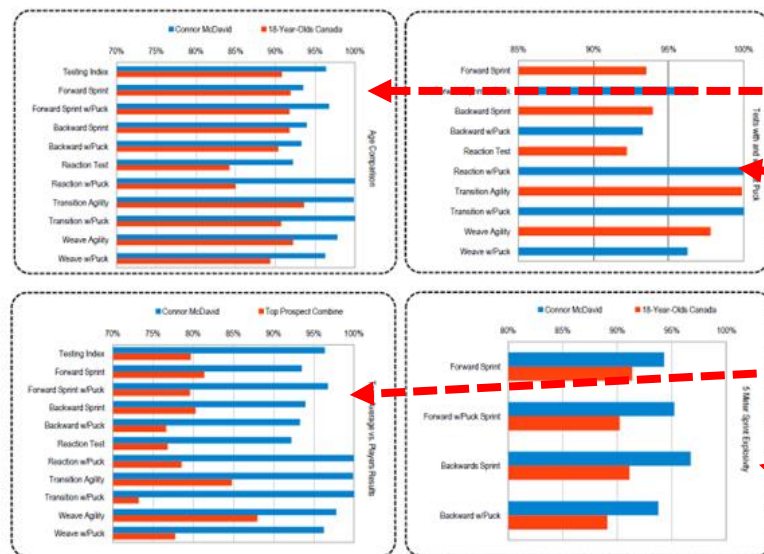


The Testing Index represents the average value of all ten test skills. Connor McDavid scored 96.36% in CHL/NHL Top Prospects Testing 2015.

The top results were achieved during the 2013-2015 CHL/NHL Top Prospects On-Ice Testings by 18-year-old players and are shown as 100%. These players play in the NHL today. The goal of the test takers should be to get as close as possible to the 100% mark.

Green is a Swiss National League Level (92-96%), Red is a Swiss League Level (88-92%)

DATA ANALYZES SHOWN GRAPHICALLY



Comparison of tested players vs. peers of the same age from the Top Prospects database in Canada.

Test comparison tests with the puck and without the puck.

Designed as a team test, it shows the player's strengths and weaknesses compared to the average values of the team players.

Explosiveness test is measured on the first five meters in the four sprint tests compared to the peer players (same age) from the Top Prospects database.
